Security Policy

The TIPPCO Soccer Association (TSA) and the organizers of the Soccer Extreme Tournament want to ensure the safety of all players, coaches, referees and spectators. The Soccer Extreme Tournament has developed this policy to ensure the safety of all its participants. If at any time any participant has questions regarding tournament security, please contact either the Tournament Director, a field Marshall, or a member of the Tournament Committee. These individuals may be found at the fields or the tournament headquarters tent.

1. It is the expectation that each coach and manager will monitor their players, parents and spectators to promote a positive, friendly and incident free tournament.
2. The Field Marshall will involve the Tournament Director to resolve any incident. The Field Marshall will be in contact with the Tournament Director at all times by radio.
3. For each age group, the fields will have a Field Marshall assigned to them. They will have a fluorescent vest in order to distinguish them out on the fields.
4. If all of the above does not resolve the incident, an onsite uniformed officer will be summoned for assistance.
5. A uniformed officer will be hired for the tournament weekend to patrol the fields at all times. If the uniformed officer can not resolve the incident, additional local law enforcement will be called in to remove from the tournament site, any person(s) involved in the incident.
6. All significant incidents will be reported by the Tournament Director to the attendee's club and state association.
7. Local law enforcement, fire stations and an urgent care medical facility will be notified of the tournament. All are located less than a mile from fields.
8. Onsite trainers will be available at the fields throughout the tournament and will be available to assist with injuries. An urgent care medical facility is located less

than one mile away. The tournament committee in conjunction with the onsite police officer will summon ambulance service if required and escort the ambulance to the parties in need.
